ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on June 29, 1995, in Hobbs, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 5th day of July, 1995, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Coastal Management Corporation, seeks approval for an unorthodox oil well location in the Southwest Gladiola-Devonian Pool to be drilled 642 feet from the South line and 2434 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 27, Township 12 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The W/2 SE/4 of said Section 27 is to be dedicated to said well forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

(3) Prior to the hearing, the applicant requested this matter be dismissed.


(4) Dismissal of this case should therefore be granted.
