ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on April 4, 1996, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 23rd day of April, 1996, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:


- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Penwell Energy, Inc., seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the N/2 of Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, thereby forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing. Said unit is to be dedicated to the proposed J. D. Federal "33" Well No. 1 to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 2080 feet from the East line (Unit B) of said Section 33.
- (3) Prior to the hearing, the applicant requested this matter be dismissed.
- (4) Dismissal of this case should therefore be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Case No. 11483 is hereby dismissed.
