**APPLICATION OF XERIC OIL & GAS CORPORATION FOR COMPULSORY
POOLING, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.**

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on January 22, 1998 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 4th day of February, 1998, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Xeric Oil & Gas Corporation, seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Abo formation underlying the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, thereby forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 40-acre spacing within said vertical extent, which presently includes but is not necessarily limited to the Undesignated House-San Andres Pool, Undesignated South House-Blinebry Pool, Undesignated Warren-Blinebry-Tubb Oil and Gas Pool, Undesignated East Warren-Tubb Pool, and Undesignated House-Drinkard Pool. Said unit is to be dedicated to its Hall Well No. 1 to be drilled at a standard oil well location thereon.
- (3) Prior to the hearing, the applicant requested this matter be dismissed.
- (4) Dismissal of this case should therefore be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Case No. 11882 is hereby dismissed.
