NOW, on this 5<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2000, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner,

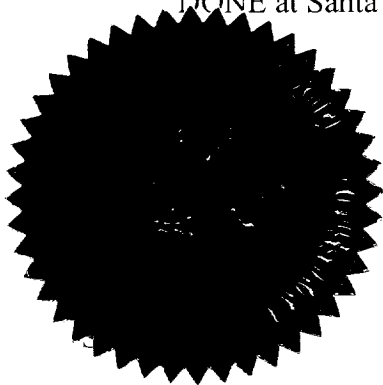
FINDS THAT:

The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:
