BY THE DIVISION:

This case came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on April 6, 2000, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 12th day of April, 2000, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner,

FINDS THAT:

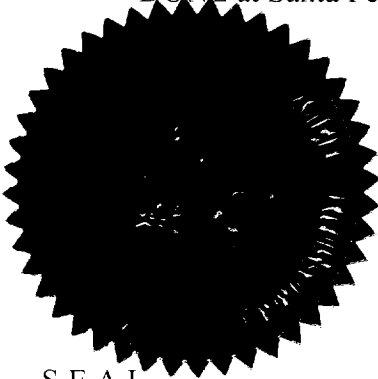
- (1) Due public notice has been given and the Division has jurisdiction of this case and its subject matter.
- (2) The applicant, Clayton Williams Energy, Inc., seeks approval to complete its New Mexico "EO" State Com. Well No. 1 (**API No. 30-015-25077**), located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of produced salt water for disposal purposes into the Cisco formation.
- (3) On February 24, 2000 Clayton Williams Energy, Inc. filed this same application with the Division for administrative review pursuant to Division Rule 701.B.
- (4) By Administrative Order SWD-763, dated March 10, 2000, the Division approved the subject application, thereby making this case unnecessary.
- (5) Furthermore, the applicant, prior to the hearing, requested this matter be dismissed.

(6) Dismissal of this case should therefore be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Case No. 12357 is hereby dismissed.
