ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on January 13, 1960, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this <u>18th</u> day of January, 1960, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the proposed abolishment of the Huerfano-Dakota Pool and of the West Kutz-Dakota Pool, both in San Juan County, and the proposed extension of the Angels Peak-Dakota Pool to include the aforementioned pools and intervening acreage in San Juan County, New Mexico, should be <u>dismissed</u> pending further study.

(3) That there is need for certain extensions to the Aztec-Fruitland Pool, the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Angels Peak-Gallup Oil Pool, the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool, the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool, and the South Los Pinos-Dakota Pool, all in San Juan County, New Mexico, to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, both in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico, and to the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba, Sandoval, and San Juan Counties, New Mexico. -2-Case No. 1860 Order No. R-1578

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That the proposed abolishment of the Huerfano-Dakota Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, is hereby <u>dismissed</u>.

(b) That the proposed abolishment of the West Kutz-Dakota Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, is hereby <u>dismissed</u>.

(c) That the Aztec-Fruitland Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

(d) That the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

That the effective date of this order and of all the creations and extensions included herein shall be February 1, 1960.
