ARRIBA COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on June 10, 1960, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 16th day of June, 1960, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Gallup formation, said pool to bear the designation La Plata-Gallup Oil Pool. Said La Plata-Gallup Oil Pool was discovered by Standard Oil Company of Texas Federal 12 Well No. 5-1, located in the SE/4 SW/4, Section 5, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, NMPM. It was completed March 22, 1959. The top of the perforations is at 5347 feet.

(3) That there is need for certain extensions to the Aztec-Fruitland Pool, the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool, the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool, the Angels Peak-Dakota Pool, and the West Kutz-Dakota Pool, all in San Juan County, New Mexico; and to the South Blanco-Dakota Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Gallup production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the La Plata-Gallup Oil Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 13 WEST, NMPM
Section 5: S/2

(b) That the Aztec-Fruitland Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

Section 32: NE/4

(c) That the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

Section 18: W/2
Section 19: N/2
Section 20: W/2 & SE/4
Section 28: SW/4
Section 29: N/2 & SE/4

(d) That the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

(e) That the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 16 WEST, NMPM
Section 15: NE/4 NW/4

TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 16 WEST, NMPM
Section 27: NE/4 NW/4 & SW/4 NE/4

(f) That the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and

the same is hereby extended to include therein:

Section 20: SE/4 NW/4

(g) That the Angels Peak-Dakota Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 28 NORTH, RANGE 10 WEST, NMPM
Section 16: W/2

TOWNSHIP 28 NORTH, RANGE 11 WEST, NMPM
Section 15: S/2
Section 16: All
Section 22: All
Section 23: All
Section 24: W/2

(h) That the South Blanco-Dakota Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

(i) That the West Kutz-Dakota Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:


