APPLICATION OF JAL OIL COMPANY AND OLSEN OILS, INC. FOR A REVISION OF THE JALMAT GAS POOL RULES TO CREATE A CATEGORY OF "DISTRESS" WELLS WHICH WOULD BE EXEMPT FROM GAS PRORATION.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for reconsideration upon the petition of Jal Oil Company and Olsen Oils, Inc. for a rehearing in Case No. 2014, Order No. R-1744, heretofore entered by the Commission on the 4th day of August, 1960.

NOW, on this <u>31st</u> day of August, 1960, the Oil Conservation Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the petition for rehearing,

FINDS:

(1) That the petition for rehearing does not allege that the applicant has any new or additional evidence to present in this case.

(2) That in view of the fact that the Commission has twice considered generally the issues in question, further consideration would be repetitious and would serve no useful purpose.

(3) That accordingly the petition for rehearing should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the petition of Jal Oil Company and Olsen Oils, Inc. for a rehearing in Case No. 2014, Order No. R-1744, be and the same is hereby denied.
