ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. July 15, 1952, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 5th day of August, 1952, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony adduced and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

> Township 27 North. Range 11 West. NMPM E/2 Section 29

(3) That the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

> Township 30 North. Range 10 West. NMPM S/2 Section 18, SE/4 Section 18

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Oil Conservation Commission be, and the same hereby is approved, as follows:

(1) That the boundaries of the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, be, and the same hereby are extended to include:

> Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM E/2 Section 29

(2). That the boundaries of the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, be and the same hereby are extended to include:

> Township 30 North, Range 10 West, NMPM S/2 Section 17; SE/4 Section 18
