Baxter, is hereby authorized to drill a well at an unorthodox location 1295 feet from the South line and 1411 feet from the West line of Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Maljamar (Grayburg-San Andres) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, as a producing well in its Maljamar (Grayburg-San Andres) Unit Waterflood Project."
