THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN ROOSEVELT AND LEA COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on August 15, 1962, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this <u>16th</u> day of August, 1962, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Montoya formation, said pool to bear the designation of North Justis-Montoya Pool. Said North Justis-Montoya Pool was discovered by J. C. Williamson, Westates Federal No. 8, located in the NW/4, Unit E, of Section 1, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM. It was completed March 3, 1962. The top of perforations is 7070 feet.

(3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Waddell formation, said pool to bear the designation of North Justis-Waddell Pool. Said North Justis-Waddell Pool was discovered by Texaco Inc., G. L. Erwin (b) NCT-2, No. 3, located in the SE/4, Unit I, of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM. It was completed April 27, 1962. The top of perforations is 8246 feet. -2-CASE No. 2619 Order No. R-2306

(4) That there is need for certain extensions to the Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, the Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool, the Blinebry Pool, the South Crossroads-Devonian Pool, the Hobbs Pool, the Justis-Blinebry Pool, the North Justis-Blinebry Pool, the North Justis-Ellenburger Pool, the North Justis-Fusselman Pool, the North Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pool, the Lea-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, the South Lane-Pennsylvanian Pool, the Medicine Rock-Devonian Pool, the Saunders Permo-Pennsylvanian Pool, the East Saunders Permo-Pennsylvanian Pool, the Sawyer-San Andres Gas Pool, and the East Weir-Blinebry Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Montoya production, is hereby created and designated as the North Justis-Montoya Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

(b) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Waddell production, is hereby created and designated as the North Justis-Waddell Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

(c) That the Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool in Roosevelt and Lea Counties, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM Section 25: NW/4

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM Section 4: NW/4 Section 8: SW/4

(d) That the Blinebry Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(e) That the South Crossroads-Devonian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

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(f) That the Hobbs Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:
