ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on October 18, 1962, at Farmington, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 20th day of March, 1963, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the attorney for the owners of the subject well stipulated at the hearing that the well would be producing or satisfactorily plugged within 90 days from the date of the hearing.

(3) That the subject well was producing within the stipulated 90-day period.

(4) That this case should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Case No. 2666 is hereby dismissed.

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(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
