THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN RIO ARRIBA AND SAN JUAN COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on July 17, 1963, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 22nd day of July, 1963, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by Law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Gallup formation, said pool to bear the designation of Many Rocks-Gallup Oil Pool. Said Many Rocks-Gallup Oil Pool was discovered by Curtis J. Little, Navajo 27 No. 2, located in Unit N of Section 27, Township 32 North, Range 17 West, NMPM. It was completed in Gallup on November 15, 1962. The top of perforation: is 1240 feet.

(3) That there is need for certain extensions to the Tapacito-Fictured Cliffs Pool, the Devils Fork-Gallup Fool, the Fuerto Chiquito-Gallup Oil Fool, and the Boulder-Mancos Oil Fool, all in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, classified as an Oil Pool for Gallup production, is hereby created and designated as the Many Rocks-Gallup Oil Pool, consisting of the following described area:

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> TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 16 WEST, NMPM SECTION 6: S/2 SW/4 SECTION 7: W/2, SE/4 and S/2 NE/4 SECTION 17: N/2 NW/4 SECTION 18: N/2 NE/4

> TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 17 WEST, NMPM SECTION 1: W/2, SE/4 and S/2 NE/4 SECTION 2: NE/4 SECTION 12: NE/4

TOWNSHIP 32 NORTH, RANGE 17 WEST, NMPM SECTION 27: S/2 SE/4 and SE/4 SW/4 SECTION 34: NE/4, N/2 SE/4 and NE/4 SW/4 SECTION 35: SW/4, S/2 NW/4 and S/2 SE/4

(b) That the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, NMPM SECTION 6: NE/4

(c) That the Devils Fork-Gallup Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 24 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, NMPM SECTION 8: W/2 NW/4, E/2 SW/4 and W/2 SE/4 SECTION 9: SW/4 and W/2 SE/4

(d) That the Euerto Chiquito-Gallup Oil Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 1 EAST, NMPM SECTION 29: N/2 SE/4 (partial)

(e) That the Boulder-Mancos Oil Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 28 NORTH, RANGE 1 WEST, NMPM SECTION 10: SE/4 SE/4

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the effective date of this order and all creations and extensions included herein shall be August 1, 1963.
