ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on November 17, 1965, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 22nd day of November, 1965, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Devonian formation, said pool to bear the designation of West Bronco-Devonian Pool. Said West Bronco-Devonian Pool was discovered by Ashmun & Hilliard, Maxwell No. 1, located in Unit F of Section 6, Township 13 South, Range 38 East, NMPM. It was completed in Devonian on September 6, 1965. The depth to casing shoe is 12,223 feet.

(3) That there is need for certain extensions to the North Bagley-Lower Pennsylvanian Pool, the North Bagley-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool, the Justis Gas Pool, the Justis-Blinebry Pool, the Justis-Tubb Drinkard Pool, and the Lusk-Seven Rivers Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico. Further, that the proposed extension to the Lane-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, should be dismissed pending further study.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Devonian production, is hereby created and designated as the West Bronco-Devonian Pool, consisting of the following described area:

(b) That the North Bagley-Lower Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

SECTION 8: NE/4  
SECTION 9: NW/4

(c) That the North Bagley-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

SECTION 15: SW/4  
SECTION 16: S/2  
SECTION 22: SW/4

(d) That the Justis Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 35: E/2

TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 2: NE/4

(e) That the Justis-Blinebry Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 26: SE/4

(f) That the Justis-Tubb Drinkard Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 26: SE/4

(g) That the proposed extension to the Lane-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 11: S/2

is hereby dismissed.

(h) That the Lusk-Seven Rivers Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM  
SECTION 3: NE/4

That the effective date of this order and all creations and extensions included herein shall be December 1, 1965.
