ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on July 9, 1969, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 15th day of July, 1969, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Sam Boren, seeks authority to complete his Barbera State "A" Well No. 1, located in Unit P of Section 6, Township 12 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, East Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, as a dual completion to produce oil from the East Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool through 2 3/8-inch tubing and to dispose of produced salt water down the annulus between the 4 1/2-inch production casing string and the 8 5/8-inch intermediate casing string into the San Andres and Glorieta formations in the open-hole interval from approximately 4060 feet to 6562 feet.

(3) That the produced salt water should be continuously treated prior to injection to prevent casing corrosion and coupon corrosion tests should be conducted continuously on said well and

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the results thereof filed quarterly with the Commission until further notice from the Secretary-Director of the Commission.

(4) That approval of the dual completion and salt water disposal as set out above will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, Sam Boren, is hereby authorized to complete his Barbera State "A" Well No. 1, located in Unit P of Section 6, Township 12 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, East Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, as a dual completion to produce oil from the East Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool through 2 3/8-inch tubing and to dispose of produced salt water down the annulus between the 4 1/2-inch production casing string and the 8 5/8-inch intermediate casing string into the San Andres and Glorieta formations in the open-hole interval from approximately 4060 feet to 6562 feet;

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the produced salt water shall be continuously treated prior to injection to prevent casing corrosion; that coupon corrosion tests shall be conducted continuously on said well and the results thereof filed quarterly with the Commission until further notice from the Secretary-Director of the Commission;

PROVIDED FURTHER, that the applicant shall submit monthly reports of his disposal operations in accordance with Rules 704 and 1120 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
