CORPORATION TO DIRECTIONALLY DRILL, LEA
COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on May 27, 1970,
at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Elvis A. Utz.

NOW, on this 10th day of June, 1970, the Commission, a
quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record,
and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised
in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by
law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject
matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Pan American Petroleum Corporation,
seeks authority to locate its Byers "A" Well No. 30 at a surface
location 663 feet from the North line and 1935 feet from the West
line of Section 3, Township 19 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Hobbs
(Grayburg-San Andres) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and direction-
ally drill said well in a northwesterly direction to a bottom-hole
location in said pool approximately 330 feet from the North line
and 1650 feet from the West line of said Section 3.
- (3) That there is an existing drilling pad at the proposed
surface location.
- (4) That there are buildings at or near a surface location
330 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of
said Section 3.
- (5) That approval of the subject application will permit
the applicant to utilize the existing drilling pad, avoid certain

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surface obstructions, will prevent waste, and will not violate correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, is hereby authorized to locate its Byers "A" Well No. 30 at a surface location 663 feet from the North line and 1935 feet from the West line of Section 3, Township 19 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Hobbs (Grayburg-San Andres) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and to directionally drill said well in a northwesterly direction to a bottom-hole location in said pool 330 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of said Section 3.


(2) That subsequent to the above-described directional drilling, a continuous multi-shot directional survey shall be made of the well-bore from total depth to the surface with shot points not more than 100 feet apart; that the operator shall cause the surveying company to forward a copy of the survey report directly to the Santa Fe office of the Commission, Box 2088, Santa Fe, New Mexico, and that the operator shall notify the Commission's Hobbs District Office of the date and time said survey is to be commenced.


(3) That Form C-105 shall be filed in accordance with Commission Rule 1105 and the operator shall indicate thereon true vertical depths in addition to measured depths.

(4) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
