ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on September 16, 1970 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this <u>17th</u> day of February, 1971, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That Stanley Leonard Jones, dba Francisca Corporation, is the owner and operator of the Francisca Corporation Beeman Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 2, Township 24 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(3) That the Francisca Corporation Beeman Well No. 1 has been abandoned and should be plugged in order to confine permanently all oil, gas, and/or water in the separate strata originally containing them in order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights. -2-CASE No. 4413 Order No. R-4105

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Stanley Leonard Jones, dba Francisca Corporation, is hereby ordered to plug the Francisca Corporation Beeman Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 2, Township 24 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in accordance with a plugging program approved by the Artesia District Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

(2) That Stanley Leonard Jones, dba Francisca Corporation shall complete plugging operations on the above-described well on or before April 1, 1971, and shall notify the District Supervisor, District 2, Oil Conservation Commission, Drawer DD, Artesia, New Mexico, of the exact date and time plugging operations are to commence.

(3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
