ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on July 12, 1972, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner, Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this 19th day of July, 1972, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Atlantic Richfield Company, seeks, as an exception to Rule 506 of the Commission Rules and Regulations, a limiting gas-oil ratio of 6,000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil in the Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the reservoir characteristics of the subject pool presently available justify the establishment of a gas-oil ratio limitation of 6,000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of liquid hydrocarbons.
- (4) That an additional volume of 800 MCF per day of casinghead gas production is anticipated to be produced from the Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pool at a gas-oil ratio of 6,000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil.
- (5) That the anticipated volume of additional casinghead gas may be produced from the Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pool without waste.

(6) That in order to afford to the owner of each property in the Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pool the opportunity to produce his just and equitable share of the oil and gas in the subject pool and for this purpose to use his just and equitable share of the reservoir energy, a limiting gas-oil ratio of 6,000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of liquid hydrocarbons should be established for the subject pool.

(7) That approval of the subject application will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That, effective September 1, 1972, the limiting gas-oil ratio in the Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, shall be 6,000 cubic feet of gas for each barrel of oil produced.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
