# THE APPLICATION OF THE COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CALLING FOR THE CREATION OF NEW POOLS AND EXTENSION OF EXISTING POOLS IN LEA AND EDDY COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

## ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on May 19, 1954, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 25th day of May, 1954, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and exhibits received at said hearing,

## FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That a new pool should be created in Eddy County, New Mexico, as properly advertised, to be designated the Angell-Seven Rivers Pool.

(3) That extensions should be approved as advertised, and as modified in testimony presented at the subject hearing, for the following pools: Denton-Wolfcamp, Dollarhide-Queen, Langlie Mattix and Lovington-Paddock (all of which are oil pools); and for the Eumont Gas Pool.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Oil Conservation Commission be, and the same hereby is approved, as follows:

(a) That a new pool should be created in Eddy County, New Mexico, classified is an oil pool for Seven Rivers production, designated as the Angell-Seven Rivers Pool, ind described as:

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TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 28 EAST, NMPM NW/4 of Section 28 (b) That the Denton-Wolfcamp Pool boundary as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM S/2 of Section 23

(c) That the Dollarhide-Queen Pool boundary as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM All of Section 4 (lying within the State of New Mexico)

(d) That the Langlie-Mattix Pool Boundary as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM  $\overline{NE/4}$  NE/4, S/2 NE/4, SE/4 and NE/4 SW/4 Section 24

(e) That the Lovington-Paddock Pool bound ary as heretofore classified, defined and described should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM E/2 of Section 2

(f) That the Eumont Gas Pool boundary as heretofore classified, defined and described should be extended to include:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM Lots 1 - 16, incl., and SE/4 Section 1; Lots 1 - 10, incl., and Lots 15 and 16 of Section 2; Lots 1, 2, 7 and 8 of Section 3; E/2 of Section 12; E/2 and SW/4 of Section 13; SE/4 Section 14

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM All of Sections 7 and 18
