IN THE MATTER OF DIVISION CASE NO. 5438 BEING REOPENED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF DIVISION ORDER NO. R-4996, WHICH ORDER CREATED AND PROMULGATED TEMPORARY SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE FAIRVIEW MILLS-WOLFCAMP GAS POOL, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

## ORDER OF THE DIVISION

## BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8 a.m. on August 28, 1985, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this <u>27th</u> day of September, 1985, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

## FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) By Division Order No. R-4996, dated April 8, 1975, the Division created, defined, and classified the Fairview Mills-Wolfcamp Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and Temporary Special Rules and Regulations were promulgated therefor, including a provision for 640-acre spacing and proration units.

(3) Pursuant to the provisions of said Order No. R-4996, this case was reopened to allow the operators in the subject pool to appear and show cause why the Fairview Mills-Wolfcamp Gas Pool should not be developed on standard spacing and proration units.

(4) Since the inception of the Fairview Mills-Wolfcamp Gas Pool, only one well has produced from the pool, the Exxon Corporation Fairview Mills Federal Well No. 1 located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 14, Township 25 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, which was also the discovery well for the subject pool.

(5) Said well produced from the Wolfcamp formation between August, 1975 and July, 1976 and was plugged in 1976.

(6) At the time of the hearing there were no appearances by interested or affected parties.

(7) It is not known at this time whether additional wells will be completed in the subject pool.

(8) In the absence of additional testimony showing why the Fairview Mills-Wolfcamp Gas Pool should not be developed on standard spacing and proration units, the Temporary Special Rules and Regulations promulgated by Division Order No. R-4996 should be rescinded and said pool should be governed by the Statewide Rules.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The Temporary Special Rules and Regulations for the Fairview Mills-Wolfcamp Gas Pool, promulgated by Division Order No. R-4996, dated April 8, 1975, are hereby rescinded and the pool is placed under the Statewide Rules.

(2) Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
