THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING, CONTRACTING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN RIO ARRIBA, SANDOVAL AND SAN JUAN COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on November 19, 1975, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 16th day of December, 1975, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new gas pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation, said pool to bear the designation of Nipp-Pictured Cliffs Pool. Said Nipp-Pictured Cliffs Pool was discovered by the Dugan Production Corporation Chaco Plant Well No. 1, located in Unit O of Section 17, Township 26 North, Range 12 West, NMPM. It was completed in the Pictured Cliffs formation on April 11, 1975. The top of the perforated interval is at 1,143 feet.

(3) That there is need for the contraction of the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties by deletion of certain acreage that is to be included in the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool.

(4) That there is need for certain extensions to the Campo-Gallup Pool, the South Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, the Otero-Chacra Pool, the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool, and the Wild Horse-Gallup -2-Case No. 5590 Order No. R-5129

Pool, all in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, the Angels Peak-Gallup Pool, the Aztec-Fruitland Pool, the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Bloomfield-Chacra Pool, the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Harris Mesa-Chacra Pool, the Ojo-Pictured Cliffs Pool, and the Waw-Pictured Cliffs Pool, all in San Juan County, New Mexico, the Rusty-Menefee Oil Pool in Sandoval County, New Mexico, and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Escrito-Gallup Oil Pool, and the Largo-Chacra Pool, all in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Pictured Cliffs production, is hereby created and designated as the Nipp-Pictured Cliffs Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

(1) That, pursuant to Section 65-3-14.5, NMSA 1953, contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 1969, any well which, by virtue of any of the above pool extensions, is subject to pool rules providing for spacing or proration units larger than the one which is presently dedicated thereto, shall have 60 days from the effective date of this order in which to file new Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit for the pool to said well, or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Commission. Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proportion to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Commission within said 60day period shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable.

(2) That the effective date of this order and all creations, extensions, and abolishments included herein shall be January 1, 1976.
