FINDS:

(1) That due notice of the time and place of hearing and the purpose thereof having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That extensions of the Dollarhide-Drinkard, Dollarhide-Queen and Lazy 'J' Pools in Lea County, and of the Robinson Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, should be effected as advertised.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission be, and it hereby is approved, as follows:

(1) That the boundary of the Dollarhide-Drinkard Poel in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 25 South, RANGE 38 East, NMPM NE/4 of Section 6 39

- 15 W 3

(2) That the boundary of the Dollarhide-Queen Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 24 South, RANGE 38 East, NMPM N/2 of Section 30

(3) Extend the Lazy 'J' Pool boundary in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 13 South, RANGE 33 East, NMPM E/2 of Section 33

(4) That the boundary of the Robinson Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 17 South, RANGE 31 East, NMPM N/2 of Section 2
