ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on June 8, 1977, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this <u>21st</u> day of June, 1977, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Hudson & Hudson, seeks approval for the unorthodox locations of 14 oil wells to be drilled at the following locations in the Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico:

SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NMPM

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(3) That additional wells drilled at the aforesaid unorthodox locations will better enable applicant to produce the oil underlying the lands dedicated to said wells.

(4) That no offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox locations.

(5) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the oil in the subject pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That 14 unorthodox oil well locations are hereby approved to be drilled in the Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico:

SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NMPM
