"(1) That all mineral interests, whatever they may be, in the Pictured Cliffs formation underlying the NW/4 of oversize Section 18, Township 25 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, are hereby pooled to form a 196.97-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit to be dedicated to a well to be drilled at a standard location thereon."
