ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on November 12, 1980, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this 17th day of November, 1980, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Conoco Inc., seeks authority to complete its Warren Unit Well No. 82, located in Unit G of Section 35, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, as a dual completion (conventional) to produce oil from the Blinebry Oil and Gas or Warren-Tubb Pools and the D-K Abo Pool.

(3) That at the hearing the applicant amended its application to request that only the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool production and the D-K Abo Pool production be considered for dual completion.

(4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.

(5) That approval of the subject application will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, Conoco Inc., is hereby authorized to complete its Warren Unit Well No. 82, located in Unit G of Section 35, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, as a dual completion (conventional) to produce oil from the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool and the D-K Abo Pool through parallel strings of tubing with separation of the two zones achieved by means of a packer set at a depth of approximately 6700 feet.


PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division Rules and Regulations insofar as said rule is not inconsistent with this order;

PROVIDED FURTHER, that the applicant shall take packer leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Gas-Oil Ratio Test Period for the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
