ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

FINDS:

1. That due notice of the time and place of hearing and the purpose thereof having been given as prescribed by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

2. That a portion of subject matter of Section (c) of the application pertaining to the extension of the Ballard Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, has now been incorporated into Order R-672-B, resulting from the hearing in Case 908, and, therefore, requires no further action herein; said subject acreage in San Juan County, New Mexico, is described as follows:

TOWNCHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 9 WEST Section 2: All Section 3: N/2 Section 4: SE/4

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That a portion of Section (c) of the application in Case 955 covering the following described properties: All of Section 2, N/2 Section 3, SE/4 of Section 4, Township 26 North, Pange 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, be and the same is hereby <u>dismissed</u>.
