BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-7222 dated February 25, 1983, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Finding No. (3) on pages 1 and 2 of Order No. R-7222 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Atoka formation, said pool to bear the designation of Gatuna Canyon-Atoka Gas Pool. Said Gatuna Canyon-Atoka Gas Pool was discovered by the TXO Production Company Keohane Federal Com Well No. 1 located in Unit H of Section 33, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Atoka formation on May 5, 1982. The top of the perforations is at 11,310 feet."

That paragraph (b) on page 3 of Order No. R-7222 is (2) hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(b) That a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Atoka production is hereby created and designated as the Gatuna Canyon-Atoka Gas Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NMPM Section 33: E/2"
