(1) That motion has been filed to dismiss, by applicant in this case, therefore application should be dismissed.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That application of Gulf Oil Corporation for an order granting approval of two non-standard drilling and proration units consisting of the N/2 SW/4 and S/2 SW/4 of Section 13, Township 17 South, Range 38 East, in exception to paragraph 1 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the South Knowles Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as set forth in Order No. R-638-B and the drilling of wells thereon, be and the same is hereby dismissed.
