ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on June 14, 1956, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 9th day of July, 1956, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the proposed creation of a new pool in McKinley County, New Mexico, as set forth in Paragraph (a) of the application and advertised as the Walker Dome Lower Mancos Oil Pool should be readvertised for jurisdictional purposes.

(3) That there is need for certain extensions to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico, the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, and the Canyon Largo-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 5 WEST, NMPM
All Section 6
N/2 Section 7

(b) That the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:


TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 8 WEST, NMPM

(c) That the Canyon Largo-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:


TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, NMPM


