ORDER CREATING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN  
POOLS IN CHAVES AND EDDY COUNTIES,  
NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on September 23, 1987, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner David R. Catanach.

NOW, on this 1st day of October, 1987, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) There is need for the creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Bone Spring formation, said pool to bear the designation of Azotea Mesa-Bone Spring Pool. Said Azotea Mesa-Bone Spring Pool was discovered by the Indrex, Inc. Four Forks Federal Well No. 1 located in Unit H of Section 15, Township 22 South, Range 25 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Bone Spring formation on June 19, 1987. The top of the perforations is at 4,345 feet.

(3) There is need for certain extensions to the Aid Yates-Seven Rivers Pool and the Red Lake Atoka-Morrow Gas Pool, both in Eddy County, New Mexico, and the West Pecos Slope-Abo Gas Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(a) A new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Bone Spring production, is hereby created and designated as the Azotea Mesa-Bone Spring Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 25 EAST, NMPM  
Section 15: NE/4

(b) The Aid Yates-Seven Rivers Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 29 EAST, NMPM  
Section 19: NW/4

(c) The West Pecos Slope-Abo Gas Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 22 EAST, NMPM  
Section 27: SW/4  
Section 34: All  
Section 35: SW/4

TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 23 EAST, NMPM  
Section 4: All

(d) The Red Lake Atoka-Morrow Gas Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 27 EAST, NMPM  
Section 22: NW/4

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

(1) Pursuant to Section 70-2-18, NMSA 1978, contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 1969, any well which, by virtue of any of the above pool extensions, is subject to pool rules providing for spacing or proration units larger than the one which is presently dedicated thereto, shall have 60 days from the effective date of this order in which to file new Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit for the pool to said well, or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division. Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proportion to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears

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
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to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Form C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division within said 60-day period shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable.

(2) The effective date of this order and all creations and extensions included herein shall be October 1, 1987.
