THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING, ASSIGNING A DISCOVERY ALLOWABLE, REDESIGNATING, AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on May 11 and June 8, 1988, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner David R. Catanach.

NOW, on this <u>10th</u> day of June, 1988, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) There is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Devonian formation, said pool to bear the designation of Vada-Devonian Pool. Further, the discovery well for said Vada-Devonian Pool, the Union Pacific Resources Company State 26 Well No. 1 located in Unit N of Section 26, Township 10 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, is entitled to and should receive a bonus discovery allowable in the amount of 63,160 barrels of oil to be assigned over a two-year period. Said discovery well was completed in the Devonian formation on February 13, 1988. The top of the perforations is at 12,646 feet. -2-Case No. 9375 Order No. R-8667

(3) There is need for the redesignation of the Fowler-Upper Silurian Oil Pool as the Fowler-Upper Silurian Gas Pool since the only producing wells in said pool are gas wells.

(4) There is need for certain extensions to the Antelope Ridge-Atoka Gas Pool, the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool, the DK-Abo Pool, the King-Wolfcamp Pool, the Lea-Bone Spring Pool, the Lea-San Andres Pool, the Lovington-Paddock Pool, the West Lusk-Delaware Pool, the North Lusk-Seven Rivers Pool, the Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, the Sanmal-Queen Pool, the Scharb-Bone Spring Pool, the West Teas Yates-Seven Rivers Pool, the West Tonto Yates-Seven Rivers Pool, the Tubb Oil and Gas Pool, the North Vacuum Atoka-Morrow Gas Pool, the Wantz-Abo Pool, the Warren-Tubb Gas Pool, and the North Young-Bone Spring Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

(5) The effective date of this order and all creations, assignments of discovery allowables, redesignations, and extensions included herein should be June 1, 1988.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(a) A new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Devonian production is hereby created and designated as the Vada-Devonian Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM Section 26: SW/4

Further, the discovery well for said Vada-Devonian Pool, the Union Pacific Resources Company State 26 Well No. 1 located in Unit N of Section 26, Township 10 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, is hereby assigned a bonus discovery allowable of 63,160 barrels to be produced over a two-year period.

(b) The Fowler-Upper Silurian Oil Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby redesignated as the Fowler-Upper Silurian Gas Pool.

(c) The Antelope Ridge-Atoka Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM Section 34: W/2 Section 35: N/2 -3-Case No. 9375 Order No. R-8667

(d) The Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM Section 17: NW/4

(e) The DK-Abo Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM Section 25: NE/4

(f) The King-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM Section 19: SW/4

(g) The Lea-Bone Spring Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(h) The Lea-San Andres Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(i) The Lovington-Paddock Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(j) The West Lusk-Delaware Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

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(k) The North Lusk-Seven Rivers Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(1) The Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(m) The Sanmal-Queen Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(p) The West Tonto Yates-Seven Rivers Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(q) The Tubb Oil and Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

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(r) The North Vacuum Atoka-Morrow Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(s) The Wantz-Abo Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM Section 6: Lots 11, 12, 13, and 14

(t) The Warren-Tubb Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM Section 25: SW/4 Section 36: NW/4

(u) The North Young-Bone Spring Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM Section 18: NE/4

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

(1) Pursuant to Section 70-2-18, NMSA 1978, contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 1969, any well which, by virtue of any of the above pool extensions, is subject to pool rules providing for spacing or proration units larger than the one which is presently dedicated thereto, shall have 60 days from the effective date of this order in which to file new Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit for the pool to said well, or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division. Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proportion to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Form C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division within said 60-day period shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable. -6-Case No. 9375 Order No. R-8667

(2) The effective date of this order and all creations, assignments of discovery allowables, redesignations, and extensions included herein shall be June 1, 1988.
