IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:


(1) Finding Paragraph No. 20 on page 4 of said Order No. R-9067 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(20) The 1988 Survey of Combined Fixed-Rate Charges for Oil and Gas Producers, published by Ernst & Whinney, shows average overhead rates of \$4940.00 while drilling and \$524.00 while producing for a gas well drilled to 15,000 feet in this area."
