ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on December 19, 1990, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 19th day of February, 1991, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Nearburg Producing Company, seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Pennsylvanian formation, underlying the W/2 of Section 16, Township 18 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools within said vertical extent developed on 320-acre gas spacing which presently includes, but is not necessarily limited to, the Undesignated Richard Knob Atoka-Morrow Gas Pool, Undesignated Penasco Draw-Atoka Gas Pool and Undesignated Eagle Creek-Strawn Gas Pool. Said unit is to be dedicated to its proposed Ewing "E" State Well No. 1 to be drilled at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F) of said Section 16.

(3) Subsequent to the hearing the applicant was able to secure voluntary agreement with all mineral interests in the proposed spacing unit.


(4) This application should therefore be dismissed.
