**APPLICATION OF BWA OIL AND GAS FOR
COMPULSORY POOLING, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO**

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on June 13, 1991, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 27th day of June, 1991, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, BWA Oil and Gas, seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Pitchfork Ranch-Strawn Pool underlying the SW/4 NE/4 (Unit G) of Section 34, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool. Said unit is to be dedicated to its existing Moore "34" Com Well No. 1 located 1980 feet from the North and East lines of said Section 34, which was plugged and abandoned in January 1988 and was re-entered on March 30, 1990.

(3) The Division received the application in this matter on April 23, 1991 and was initially placed on the May 16, 1991 Examiner hearing docket.


(4) This case was subsequently called at the May 16, 30 and June 13, 1991 Examiner's hearings and at no time was there any written correspondence from the applicant or appearance in the hearings to inform the Division of its intent. This application should therefore be dismissed.
