ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on December 17, 1992, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 21st day of December, 1992, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Enron Oil and Gas Company, seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location 990 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 36, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, to test the Wolfcamp, Atoka and Morrow formations, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 36 is to be dedicated to said well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

(3) At this time, the applicant has requested this case be dismissed.


(4) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.
