ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on January 21, 1993, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 26th day of January, 1993, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Warrior, Inc., seeks an order approving the drilling of its Federal "D" Well No. 13 in the Eumont Oil Pool at an unorthodox oil well location 1300 feet from the South and West lines (Unit M) of Section 26, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said well is to be dedicated to a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit consisting of the SW/4 SW/4 of said Section 26.

(3) At this time the applicant has requested that this case be dismissed.


(4) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.
