FINDS THAT:


- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Condor Oil Corporation, seeks approval for eighteen unorthodox oil well locations for the purpose of completing an efficient injection/production pattern within the Northeast Hogback Waterflood Project Area in Township 30 North, Range 16 West, NMPM, Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.
- (3) Prior to the hearing, Division Administrative Order NSL-3241 was issued in this matter.
- (4) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.
