It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-9950 dated August 30, 1993, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Decretory Paragraph No. (2) on page 3 of said Order No. R-9950, be and the same, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(2) The applicant is further authorized to drill vertically from a well to be located at a standard surface coal gas well location 815 feet from the North line and 1270 feet from the East line (Unit A) of said Section 21 to an approximate depth of 2588 feet and then kick-off in a southerly direction, build angle and continue drilling horizontally in the coal seam."

(3) The corrections set forth in this order be entered <u>nunc pro tunc</u> as of August 30, 1993.
