ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

This matter came on for hearing at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on May 22, 1951, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico upon its own motion, and the Commission having heard the evidence presented and having taken the case under advisement,

FINDS:

- (1) That due notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of the case.
- (2) That new pools should be created, described and classified as follows:
- (a) McMillan Seven Rivers, pool classified as an oil pool, and described as follows:

Twp. 19 S, R. 32 E, NMPM  
S/2 NW/4, SW/4 Section 32  
SE/4 NE/4, E/2 SW/4 Section 31  
for Seven Rivers production.

- (b) South Saunders (Permo-Pennsylvanian) pool, classified as an oil pool and described as follows:

Twp. 15 S, R. 33 E, NMPM  
All sections 29, 30, 31 and 32 for Permo-  
Pennsylvanian production.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the following pools are hereby created, named, classified as oil pools and described as:

- (a) McMillan-Seven Rivers pool for Seven Rivers production, classified as an oil pool and described as.

Twp. 19 S, R. 32E, NMPM  
S/2 NW/4, SW/4, Sec. 32  
SE/4 NE/4, E/2 SW/4, Sec. 31  
Eddy County, New Mex'co

(b) South Saunders pool, for Permo-Pennsylvanian production,  
classified as an oil pool, and described as

Twp. 15 S. R. 33E, NMPM  
All Sections 29, 30, 31, and 32  
Lea County, New Mexico
