Operator called Lead Operator (Gabe) and lead operator headed out to Kristina. Instructions were given to call EMS and 911. Local fire department put out the fire Gabe called AGP Supervisor Harvey at 21:38 and Harvey immediately called the Asset Director (Scot) and safety representative (John) then headed out to Kristina. DCP safety was not present because the fire was put out and Kristina shutdown by the time notifications were made. Local EMS send operator to Artesia General Hospital via ambulance. Operator was admitted at ~22:00 and was released to duty at ~00:00. AGH administers cream to operators face. No local or state police were needed. Kristina was immediately shutdown.
