Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

The packing on a water transfer pump blew out resulting in the release of approximately 102 bbls of produced water. The packing was replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

All of the fluid remained inside of the lined containment. A vacuum truck was dispatched to recover all freestanding fluids. Concho will have the spill area evaluated for any possible impact from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation activities. Free fluids were removed and if present the impacted gravel was removed from the liner and taken to a NMOCD approved disposal facility. The liner was inspected for damage and found to have liner integrity to contain free fluids.
