



No injuries were associated with the incident. At 0128, the Coterra Control Room received a call about a possible fire at the Palmillo State 4 well, which was called in by a Melbourne employee. At 0257, the Coterra Lease Operator arrived on site and confirmed the fire had selfextinguished. After reviewing the water tank gauges, an estimated 42 barrels were in the tank. A vac truck was able to recover a total of 10 barrels water from inside the berm. The remainder of the fluid is believed to have vaporized in the fire.
