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Good afternoon Shelly,

That is correct, those areas were excavated only to 0.25 feet and the 4' delineation sample was hand-auger collected. The peach highlight on the samples at these locations, indicating they were over-excavated, was incorrect. Impacts at BH-24, BH-27, and BH-28 remain in-place from 0.25 feet down to just before 4 feet bgs.

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Hi Chuck,

After speaking on the phone with you today regarding NAPP2412958102 EMERALD FEDERAL BATTERY RELEASE, I just wanted to confirm with you that the locations of BH-24, BH-27 and BH-28 were only excavated to .25' however a 4' delineation sample was collected by hand auger on 5/2/25 at each location to vertically delineate the requested deferral area. As it stands these 3 samples in Table 3 were highlighted in peach, which says they were laterally or vertically over excavated and resampled.
