**RE: Abatement Completion Report at the K-7 Lateral Gas Gathering Pipeline, Incident ID nJK1306651178**

Mr. Jacobson,

The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received a request for an abatement completion report prepared on behalf of Enterprise Field Services, LLC(Enterprise) by Ensolum, LLC. The available information indicates Enterprise has met the provisions outlined in paragraphs A, B and D of 19.15.30.9 NMAC, **Abatement Standards and Requirements** and 19.15.30.19 NMAC, paragraphs A and B, **Completion and Termination**.

Enterprise had provided an initial Form C-141 within the allowable timeframe of (15 days) from the date of discovery. OCD approved the abatement action of source removal via excavation of the impacted vadose zone soils in 2015.

Enterprise collected eight (8) consecutive quarterly ground water samples in 2016, 2017, and 2018 from the six (6) monitoring wells, all of which had either no analytical detection or were substantially below the New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission's allowable concentrations for all constituents of concern, namely Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TPH) and Benzene, Toluene, Ethyl-Benzene, Xylenes (BTEX).

The OCD has reviewed both document submissions and determined the request for abatement termination in the "no further action request" to be approved with the following conditions of approval.

- Enterprise will plug and abandon all six (6) monitoring wells within 90 days of receipt of this letter following an approved Office of State Engineering plugging plan.
- Enterprise will submit a Plugging report detailing the plugging operations to the OCD within 120 days of receipt of this letter.
- Enterprise will submit a completed Reclamation report pursuant to 19.15.29.13 NMAC within 180 days of receipt of this letter.
