RE: **Bloomfield Crude Station Site (Abatement Plan ID: 3RP-258; Facility ID: fAB0000000343; Incident #: NAUTOFAB000044;)**

Dear Ms. Sidle,

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) is in receipt of the 3RP-258-Bloomfield Crude Station Remediation Work Plan requesting a modification of the Bloomfield Crude Station Site (Abatement Plan ID: 3RP-258), dated September 16, 2025, submitted by Western Refining Southwest LLC's (Western). This application was submitted to the OCD on September 16, 2025, through OCD Permitting under application ID: 506465. The modification request has been reviewed and is denied for the following reasons:

- a. The submitted request of “re-evaluation of the design for the anticipated municipal park at the Site” or “If the Property is not used by the City of Bloomfield, the site will remain unchanged, and no further action will be taken at the Site to address vadose zone soils” is denied.

OCD is requesting that Western is to carry out the following tasks with respect to this site;

- a. In the submitted report, three remedial options are proposed. Upon review of the proposed options, per 19.15.29 NMAC, OCD requires remediation of the impacted soils. OCD recommends the Western proposed remediation method of excavation of impacted soil. This recommendation was made based on the location of the site, remediation time, potential plume migration to nearby residences, potential use for the public by the City of Bloomfield, and the source of release remaining in place continuing to impact groundwater. Western must submit a modification to their Stage 2 plan with remediation timelines that meet the requirements of 19.15.30 NMAC no later than April 24, 2026 and addresses the following:
 - b. Impacted soil in the vadose zone must be remediated to 19.15.29 NMAC.

- c. Impacted soil identified by BH1 will be required to be remediated.
- d. Upon completion of excavation activities, groundwater monitoring activities will continue for a minimum of eight (8) quarters before requesting closure.
- e. Groundwater monitoring activities are to continue as scheduled throughout additional remediation activities.
