Dear Roy:

We anticipate drilling another wildcat in Guadalupe County in the near future. We would like to get your recommendations on where to set surface casing.

Ideally, we would like to be able to run open hole logs across the San Andreas, and have the Santa Rosa sands behind surface casing. The stratigraphic interval of this point is equivalent to 600' to 700' in the Mr. Jones #1, Sec. 32 T7N R23E. Due to anticipated structure, and relative topographic differences, this point would be approximately 250' to 350' in the new well.

Please let us know what your feelings are on this. I am looking forward to seeing you soon.

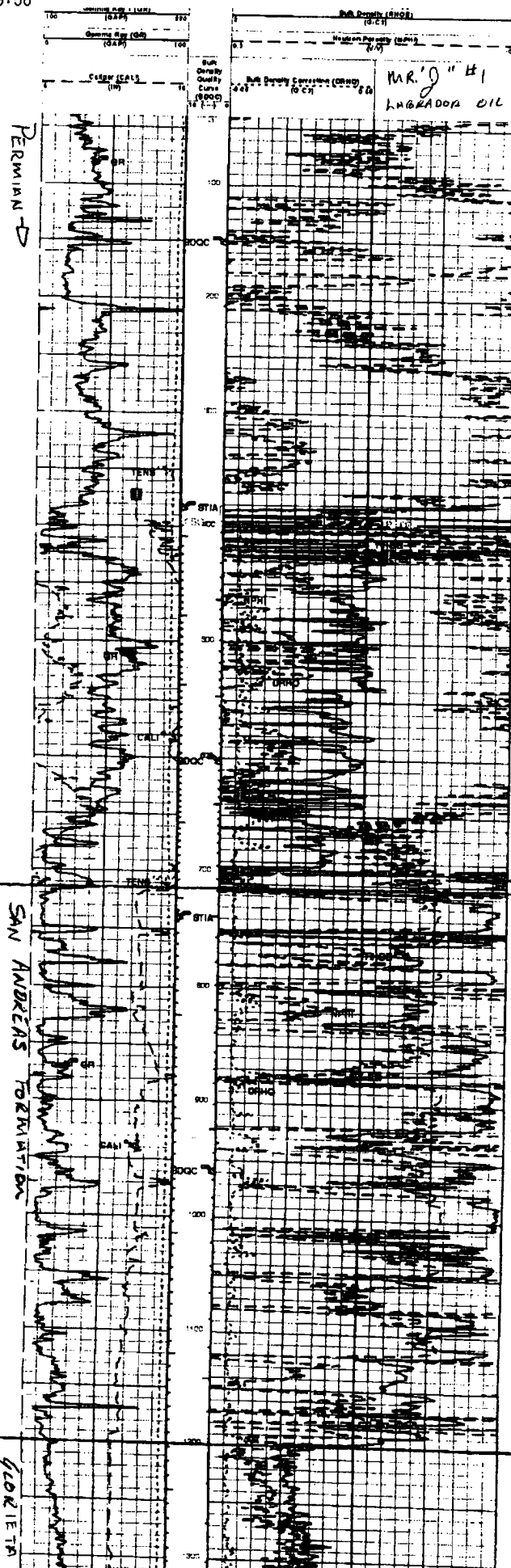
