- 5. I must keep current with fit ancial ass trances for well plugging. I understand that New Mexico requires each state or fee well that his been in tetive for more than two years and has not been plugged and released to be covered by a single-well financial assurance, even if the well is also covered by a blanket financial assurance and even if the well is on approved temporary abandonment status. See 19.15.8.9.C NMAC. I understand that I can check my compliance with the single-well financial assurance requirement by using the "I active Will Additional Financial Assurance Report" on the OCD's website
- 6. I am responsible for reporting release: as defined by 19.15.29 NMAC. I understand the OCD will look to me as the operator of record to take corrective action for releases at my wells and related facilities, including releases that occurred befor: I became operator of record.
- 7. Thave read 19.15.5.9 NMA?, commonly known as "Part 5.9," and understand that to be in compliance with its requirements I mus have the appropriate financial assurances in place, comply with orders requiring corrective action, pay penalties assessed by the courts or agreed to by me in a settlement agreement, and not have for many we is out of compliance with the inactive well rule (19.15.25.8 NMAC). If I am in violation of Part 5.9. I may not be allowed to drill, acquire or produce any additional wells, and will not be able to obtain at vinew injection permits.
