It has come to my attention that Mack Energy has plugged their well. Both wells are located in a section of ground that is being utilizing for production of pecans. As requested by the surface owner, both wells were completed with a minimal amount of surface impact. As the Mack Energy Well was closest to County Road 229, aka Haldeman Road, their location was chosen for setting meters and separation equipment for both wells. It is my understanding that Mack Energy has plugged their well and removed their equipment. Grizzly's equipment remains as its well is still active. Grizzly's equipment will be removed when the well is plugged and the well site and metering site will be restored at that time.
