RE-STIMULATION:

- 1. MIRU workover rig.
- 2. TOOH with 2-3/8" tubing.
- 3. Rig up air package and TIH w/ bit circulating to cleanout to PBTD at 13,808'
- 4. TIH w/4-1/2" RBP and pressure test to 7,500 psi (70% of burst).
- 5. Release and TOOH w/ 4-1/2" RBP and lay down same.
- 6. PU and RIH with tubing conveyed perforating guns.
- 7. Perforate within existing perforation interval (7,990'-12,895') with ~560 additional perforations
- 8. RU frac crew and iron and pressure test.
- 9. Using ball sealer isolation, frac well within existing completion interval with up to 9,900 klbs 40/70 and 70/100 mesh sand and 100 kbbl slickwater.
- 10. RDMO frac. MIRU workover rig to clean well out and reinstall tubing.

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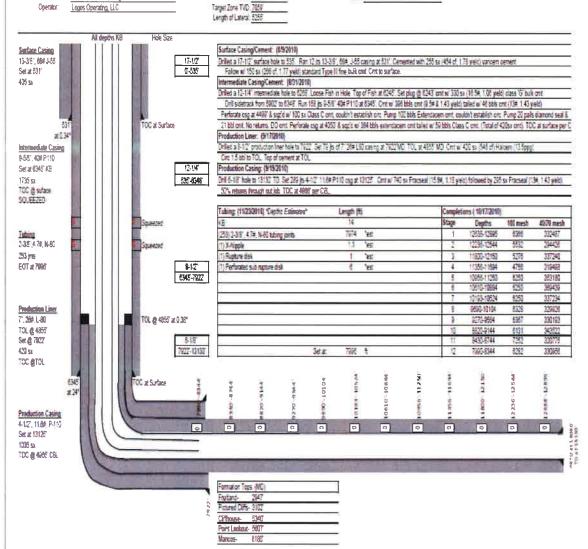
Wellbore Schematic
