**Plug #1** mix 110 sxs Class B cement with 1/4" cello flake, pump 10 sxs cement then drop 28 frac balls and pump the remaining 100 sxs and circulate to surface. SI well with 900 PSI

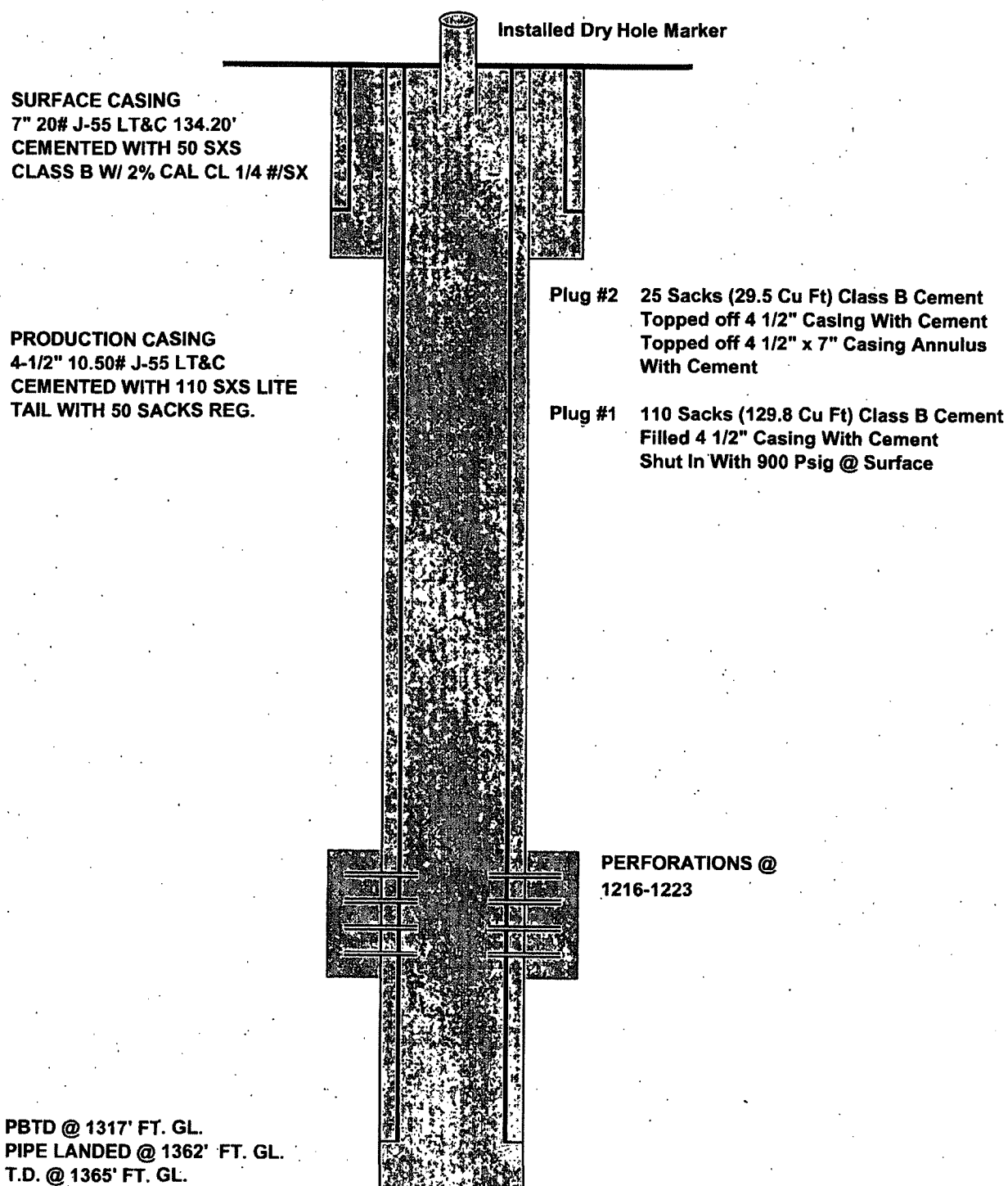
**Plug #2** with 25 sxs (29.5 cf) Class B cement found cement in 4.5" casing down 7' and in 7" x 4.5" down 40'. To top off casings. Install P&A marker.

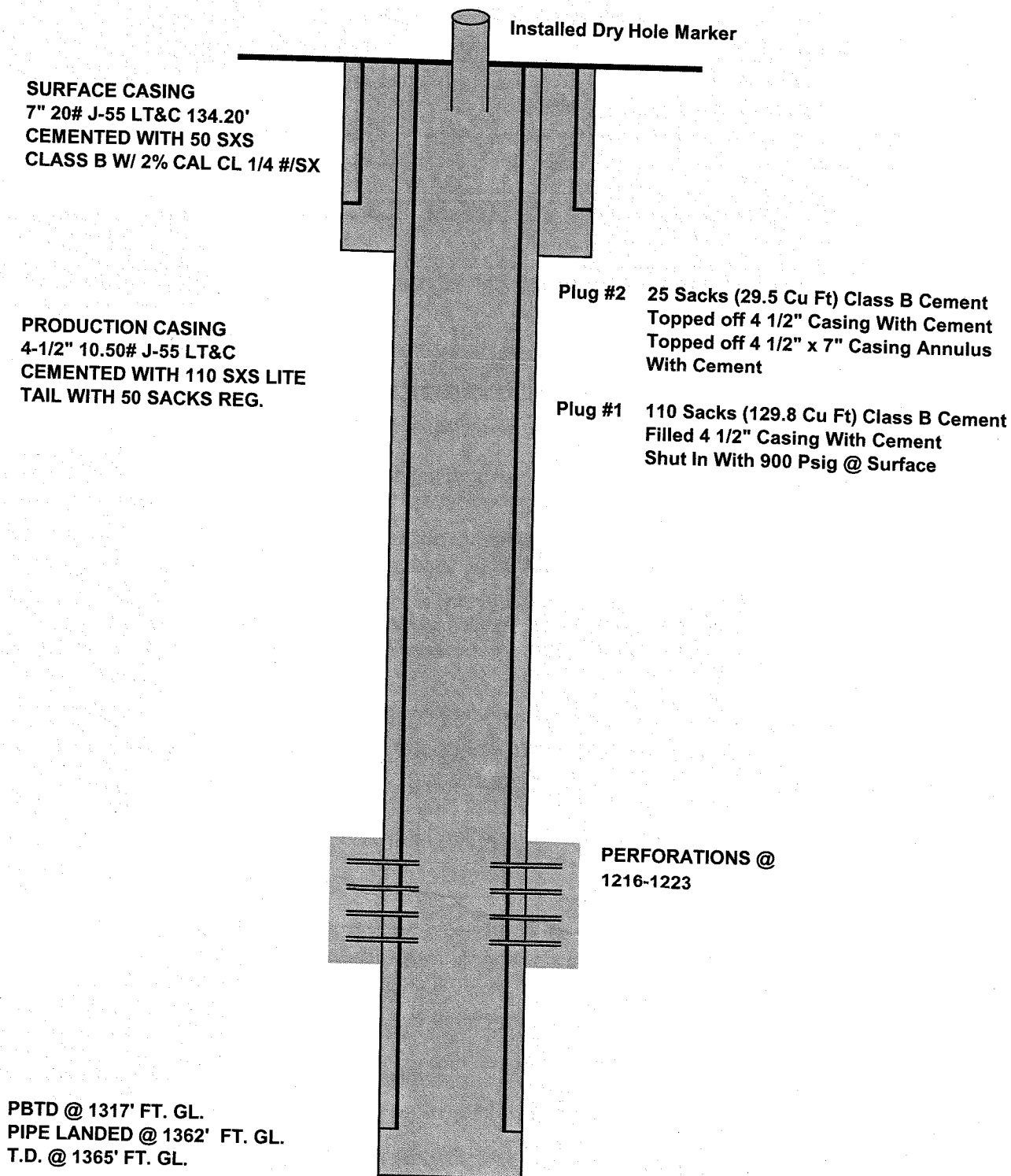
- 3/18/13 Road equipment to location. Check well pressures: tubing and bradenhead 0 PSI, casing 34 PSI. RU. TOH and LD polish rod, 2-8' pony rods, 19-3/4" plain rods, 32 - guided 3/4" rods and pump. ND wellhead. Strip on 4.5" tubing head and companion flange. Function test BOP. PU 22' in subs and tag at 1308' with 4' stick up. TOH and tally 39 joints of 2-3/8" EUE tubing, SN 2' perf sub and a tail joint, total 1287'. Note: B. Powell, NMOCD, M. Hanson, Coleman O&G and J. Joe, BLM approved procedure change. Spot plug #1 mix 110 sxs Class B cement with 1/4" cello flake, pump 10 sxs cement then drop 28 frac balls and pump the remaining 100 sxs and circulate to surface. SI well with 900 PSI. RD pump. SDFD.
